

Blackmore Billiards & Snooker Club

Byelaws

1. All games will be played in accordance with the rules of British Billiards & Snooker Control Council Rules.
2. All Players must be members of the Billiards and Snooker Club or authorised guests:-
 - a. Members over the age of eighteen (18), who have been a member (of the Billiards and Snooker Section) for more than a year are entitled to play with their guest providing:-
 - i. The guest has not been previously expelled.
 - ii. The guest only plays in games which include the member.
 - b. A guest may only be invited into the 'Club' four times in a calendar year.
 - c. Each Full/Senior member may invite up to twelve guests per Calendar year.
3. Junior Members:-
 - a. Are not permitted to sign in guests.
 - b. May only play when supervised by a Full or Senior member (who is over the age of eighteen) and is present in the room.
 - c. The maximum number of Junior members permitted in the room together is four.
4. Precedence of play on the tables:-
 - a. Club Calendar 'Online' bookings take precedence and can be booked for up to 4 hours duration by sending an email Calendar event request
 - i. To Blackmoresnookerclub@outlook.com
 - ii. Include member(s) name and Table number
 - b. Thereafter 'turn up and play' bookings will be on a first come first served basis.
 - i. If other members are waiting then games are limited to:-
 1. Snooker; Completion of a single frame.
 2. Billiards; Play to 'one hundred and fifty up' or to end of light, whichever occurs first.
 - ii. If four or more players are waiting then doubles should be played unless the waiting players consent.
 - iii. Players in play may not add their name to the 'chalk board' waiting list.
 - c. Priority of booking is given to the Competition Secretary when necessary for competition evenings.
5. Play may only take place when table light is on.

6. Players should not leave the room unattended without first locking away equipment, covering the tables and locking doors.
7. A Full or Senior member may not under any circumstances loan their key FOB to a Junior or non-member.
8. To avoid damage to the tables, please:-
 - a. Do not:
 - i. Toss coins onto the table bed.
 - ii. Put drinks on the table.
 - iii. Handle food during the course of a game.
 - b. Place balls gently on the table and then roll on to their spots
9. Please;
 - a. Return empty glasses to the bar during licensing hours.
 - b. Put empty cans in bins provided or take them with you when you leave.
 - c. Do not smoke or vape in the Billiard & Snooker Room
